

This hunting area is over 200,000 acres and located north of Yellowstone National Park. You will mostly be hunting by horseback in remote public land areas via trail heads. Bears come in all colors here and are likely in the 5 to 6-foot range. Shot opportunities are high.

This is a five-day rifle hunt. The guides will transport you to and from the hunting area, and the hunt is spot-and-stalk. Lunch will be provided. The hunter is responsible for all other food and lodging. The outfitter will field dress, skin, and transport your trophy to a taxidermist if you desire.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: Montana license is sold over-the-counter. Online bear identification test must be taken in advance.

TRM RANCH HUNTER'S SHOOTING COURSE

This is a rare opportunity to enjoy a long weekend along the Rocky Mountain Front in Montana while staying at and exploring the Boone and Crockett Club's Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch!

Guests will arrive on Friday and join B&C Director of Conservation Programs Luke Coccoli for a tour of the ranch. Attractions along the tour include historic Native American tipi rings, the Old North Trail, homestead sites, beautiful Dupuyer Creek, and the occasional wildlife sighting.

This course will be designed to offer basic to intermediate shooting instruction and actual field-course practice geared toward hunting. Topics covered could include the following but will be specifically customized to meet the winning bidder's actual wants and needs:

- · Bullet selection
- Basic load development
- How to mount a scope and bore sight a rifle
- How to zero a rifle and at what range
- · Bench rest basics

Ample practice at the shooting range will include firing from a variety of shooting positions: prone, kneeling, rock, fence post, tripod, freehand,



etc. The course will conclude midday Sunday with a discussion on the ethics of hunting and the problems associated with long range shooting.

Lodging accommodations will feature the Rasmuson Wildlife Conservation Center and all field practice will commence at the Palmer Shooting Sports Complex both on the Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch near Dupuyer, Montana.

ULTIMATE ARKANSAS DUCK HUNT PACKAGE

This two-day Arkansas duck/goose hunt with Wings of the Prairie includes two Browning Maxus II shotguns, Rig 'Em Right and Sitka Gear packages for two hunters.

Typically, Wings of the Prairie hunts within 60 miles of Stuttgart, Arkansas. This item includes two mornings of duck hunting and one afternoon of goose hunting in pre-made blinds. Additional goose or duck hunt days may be available before or after the two scheduled days depending on the outfitter's schedule.

The purchaser is responsible for lodging. Transportation during the hunt will be worked out with the outfitter. The outfitter recommends lodging somewhere near Stuttgart, Arkansas to maintain a central position to reduce drive time in the morning before hunts. There are several hotels in the area available.

Stuttgart is a one hour drive from Little Rock. Flying into Little Rock and renting a vehicle for your stay allows the most flexibility.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: Arkansas hunting license plus state and federal waterfowl stamps.

5-DAY ALBERTA DEER HUNT

Located northwest of Calgary near Caroline, Alberta, Savage Encounters finds its home nestled at the base of the eastern foothills of the Canadian Rocky Mountains. Its hilly and swampy terrain with good cover of large pines and aspen guarantee that potential game reach maturity. This area is known worldwide for its excellent trophy game.

This 5½-day hunt is for mule deer, whitetail deer and wolf. Alberta is a sleeper for great mule deer and there are some monsters here. Most of Alberta is on draw for mule deer and with limited pressure and great habitat big bucks happen. There are mule deer in the 140"-200" class and clients usually see large herds. Most mule deer hunts are conducted by stalking or stand hunting near crop land or logging blocks. If you're looking for a massive muley, look no more.

Alberta is renowned for its large whitetail deer, tipping the scales at well over 300 pounds, and our area is no exception. We have whitetail bucks in the 130"-200" class and our clients usually see a couple of these giants within range each week along with smaller bucks and does. All of our whitetail hunts are conducted from tree stands or ground blinds, hunting crop or timber country.

Chad "Savage" Lenz has lived in, and hunted this area for more than 35 years, giving him the advantage of experience when it comes to guiding hunters to the best possible locations. With 4×4 crew cabs, amphibious ATV's, horses, and quads, you'll find yourself safely arriving at your hunting area on time.

TEXAS NILGAI ANTELOPE HUNT FOR TWO ON THE HISTORIC KING RANCH

Nilgai are challenging to hunt, given their impressive eyesight, hearing, and sense of smell. Depending on what the conditions dictate, nilgai hunts can be customized for still hunting, stalking, or safari style hunts.

ITEM 31LA:09 BISON HUNT ON THE FLYING D RANCH, MONTANA

The Flying D Ranch is a spectacular, 115,000-acre property located just south of Bozeman, Montana. The property operates as a working ranch managed for the production of bison and other wildlife.

Your hunt will be 1½ days in length. You are welcome to bring up to three guests with you at no charge. We will pick you up at your hotel or meet you at our office in Bozeman between 5:00-7:00 pm the evening before your scheduled hunt day. On this evening scouting trip, we will look at the bison and the other wildlife on the ranch. We will also sight in your rifle. Early the next morning (6:00 am), we will pick you up at your hotel or meet at the office.

Once the animal is harvested, we will set it up for great pictures, field dress it and then take it to the meat processor/taxidermist. Taxidermy and processing not included.

Lunch is included in your hunt. We will have a cooler with drinks available to you in the field.

The large, mature bull bison are absolutely fearless. They like to be out in the open so that they can see their surroundings. While hunting big bulls, one of two things will happen. The bull will turn and look for the hunter or turn and walk away. Watch their tail, if it is straight up they are agitated. Bison are not dumb. They are confident that they can handle any situation. This is one of the reasons we are usually able to get within a 100 yards.

The buyer of this tag will be the second hunter of the season. Transportation during the hunt will include Jeeps and UTV's. The 7-day, free range hunt is planned for October 19th through 26th, 2022. If necessary, dates can be moved to a further date, pending availability. Past winners of this tag have harvested rams that score in the mid-180s.

The hunt includes one non-hunting guest; other non-hunters are welcome at the on-going rate. Hunt includes trophy fees, CITES fees, exportation brokerage fees to the US, and shipping of your trophy anywhere in the US.

Spanish hospitality, plush lodging, gourmet Mexican cuisine, and a

WYOMING GOVERNOR'S 2022 SHIRAS' MOOSE LICENSE

DONATED BY: Wyoming Game & Fish Department

The Wyoming 2022 Governor's Moose License is valid in these Hunt Areas: 3, 5, 20, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 38, and 41, which account for over 70 percent of Wyoming's annual Shiras' moose harvest.

The purchaser does not have to pick a specific hunt area and may hunt

different areas subject to season dates. The 5-year waiting period between moose licenses does not affect the ability to purchase a Wyoming Governor's Moose license. Purchasing this license is independent of applying for a moose license through the regular draw

process. The license fee is waived. Preference points are not affected by purchase of a Wyoming Governor's Moose license. Ninety percent of the auction proceeds are returned to Wyoming to fund moose projects via the Wyoming Governor's Big Game License Coalition.

The most successful hunts are during the rut – late September to early October. The bulls are traveling during this time looking for cows.

ITEM 31LA:13 HOSTED MISSOURI TURKEY HUNT FOR 2 HUNTERS

This is a three-day, four-night hosted Eastern turkey hunt for the spring of 2023 at a date that is mutually agreed upon. You will be the first and only hunters on a 2,400-acre farm characteristic of Northwest Missouri with hardwood timber, CRP, cattle pastures, and corn/soybean fields. State of Missouri hunting regulations permit one bird per day and hunting must cease at 1:00pm. A second turkey may be taken at no charge. Accommodations will be provided at the farmhouse.

The successful bidder will travel to Columbia or St. Louis, Missouri. This hunt includes all lodging, meals and drinks, and transport to and from the airport. Farm owner will transport hunters around the farm, and will



assist hunters throughout with local knowledge, but hunters will be calling and hunting on their own. Justin Spring, B&C Director of Big Game Records, will be camp host.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: Missouri hunting license.

3-DAY COLORADO PRONGHORN HUNT

This three-day hunt will be conducted in a game rich area of central Colorado. The antelope rifle season is typically the first 10 days of October. The hunt dynamics are post-rut and the antelope tend to be in much larger, mixed-sex groups, sometimes numbering 50 plus animals. Hunting strategies include using decoys and spot and stalk. These hunts are guaranteed

licenses due to landowner permits and normally produce better than average trophy bucks.

All of our hunting is conducted on well-managed private property where we have exclusive hunting rights. By utilizing a system of preplanned hunts on these ranches, it is unlikely that you will encounter other hunters while in the field. We limit the numbers of hunters in the field and a firearms safety code is strictly enforced.



This early rifle wears serial number 1812 and is based on a Mauser Model 98-style action with a full-length extractor. Wood and metal finishes are strong. The bore is superb. Although drilled and tapped for an included single-piece base, the rear aperture sight (Lyman 48) remains in position.


FREE-RANGE AOUDAD SHEEP HUNT IN WEST TEXAS

Indigenous to the Atlas Mountains and Barbary Coast of Northern Africa, aoudad sheep, commonly referred to as Barbary sheep, were introduced into the Northern Panhandle and Trans-Pecos regions of Texas in the late 1950's in an effort to establish a new big game hunting opportunity. They have since flourished from a few dozen animals during release period to well over 25,000 free ranging animals in Western Texas alone.

Wildlife Systems, Inc. has generously donated this hunt for one hunter for free-ranging aoudad sheep to take place in the big, unspoiled country of West Texas. This is a 3½ day, 4-night program and includes meals, lodging, guide (1x1), and game care. Average rams that have been taken in recent years sport horns that are 30" - 33" in length, but larger rams are taken every year.

On a scale of 1 -10, the physical difficulty of this hunt normally ranges from a 6 - 8 but can be highly variable and it's recommended that the hunter be at least modestly in condition and capable of comfortably walking across rocky, broken terrain that often requires some climbing. Non-resident hunting licenses can be purchased online or over the counter and are only \$48. WSI is an awardwinning outfitting and wildlife management firm that's been in business since 1987 and still co-owned and operated by its founder, wildlife biologist and conservation-activist. Greg Simons.
